

Bill Ward and Wanda Danesi



Our September meeting featured a double header with Wanda Danesi continuing her introduction of new varieties of nursery plants adaptable to bonsai training and Bill Ward creating a large saikei using an artificial resin aquarium rock as a base. Wanda showed the rapid progress of the viburnum bonsai she's training with one going from nursery pot to show tree in under two years.

Bill explained that after finding the large hollow resin rocks in aquarium stores, he enlarges the holes that are meant for fish to swim through and fills the whole thing and the pot it sits on with soil and then plants various junipers, cypress and cotoneasters. He brought an example of one previously created which is weathering well.


