Kofu Kai has an opportunity to host a workshop at next month's meeting featuring Cesar Ordoñez. Cesar will provide Olive trees and lead the workshop during the regular monthly meeting. The trees provided are worth between \$100 and \$150. Participants would bring their own tools, but wire will be provided.


