Kofu Kai welcomes Mel Ikeda for a fascinating



Would you like to learn in one short evening how to take an ordinary nursery plant and turn it into a multi trunk bonsai? Mel Ikeda grew up as part of the bonsai community, learning from his father at the Ikeda Bonsai Nursery. He has studied with John Naka, Harry Hirao and Khan Komai and belongs to many bonsai clubs including the California Bonsai Society and Nanpu Kai. He is very active in the Golden State Bonsai Federation and has been featured at their conventions and at the Bonsai A Thon as a demonstrator.

He has also taught bonsai in many venues including a long time class at the Nakaoka Center in Gardena. Mel's philosophy of bonsai is embodied in the phrase 'Bonsai No Kokoro' which means art or spirit of bonsai. He has been developing and demonstrating the very useful raft technique for years. This is a way of taking ordinary and commonly available juniper nursery stock and by mounting it sideways in a growing box, creating a raft planting which evokes a fallen tree whose branches have developed into a clump or forest over time. This is a very good approach for beginners and everyone else too and I hope to see our new members at the meeting to learn this way of creating interesting bonsai quickly.
